When shipping multiple pieces:

- A. When palletized each piece on the pallet must have a shipping label attached. List each pallet separately. (Include the number of pieces on each pallet)
- B. Not palletized each container must have a shipping label attached. List the total number of pieces and their combined weight.
- 5. Type / write clearly on the face of the bill of lading, "For customs clearance at the border contact A.N. Derringer."
